EASTLAND — Jack Hart, 73, who served in the U.S. Army during World War II, died Monday in a local hospital.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Bakker Funeral Home Chapel with the Rev. Dewey Lamb officiating. Burial will be in the Eastland Cemetery.

Born in Eastland County, Mr. Hart grew up in the Alameda community and graduated from Alameda High School. He worked for North American Aviation. A former Cisco resident, he moved to Baytown in 1960. He retired from Exxon, USA and returned to Eastland in 1980. He was a member of the Bethel Baptist Church.

Survivors include his wife, D. LaFray Reid Hart of Eastland; one son, Ernie J. Hart of San Antonio; one daughter, Linda S. Isaac Jackson Hart was born February 2, 1920 at the Bedford Community north of Cisco. He was the son of James A. and Eula *Carter* Hart. He grew up at Alameda, and graduated from Alameda High School. He attended Hardin Simmons and Texas Tech Universities. He was a veteran of WW II, serving in the US Army. He married D. LaFray Reid on Sept. 21, 1946 at Duster, Texas. He had lived in Cisco, and moved to Baytown in 1960. In 1980 he retired from EXXON USA, and returned to Eastland. He was a member of the Bethel Baptist Church of Eastland. Jack passed from this life on Monday, Sept. 27, 1993, in Eastland. He was 73 years of age.
